CAB RIDE

The steam locomotive cab ride on the Brienz Rothorn Railway is a unique and exciting experience. With correct behavior and compliance with the safety rules, participation is safe. However, failure to follow the safety regulations may result in hazards.

The cab ride takes place standing in the cab of the steam rack railway. The route has a considerable gradient; heat, noise, vibration and smoke emissions are also to be expected in the cab. These conditions place specific physical demands on the participant: freedom from vertigo, a stable stance, and sufficient physical resilience are required. The cardiovascular and respiratory systems must be sufficiently resilient.

Persons with serious health conditions, in particular cardiovascular or central nervous system disorders (e.g. epilepsy), as well as persons under the influence of medications that impair reaction ability, narcotics or alcohol, should refrain from participating. If you take medication regularly, please consult a doctor before participating.

Throughout the entire cab ride, the participant is supervised by an accompanying Brienz Rothorn Bahn specialist and instructed on the applicable safety rules. The instructions of the accompanying person must be strictly followed at all times. Incorrect behavior can lead to serious injury.
